- 2. Ms. Billy, Headmaster, introduced herself and reported on the TBLS community
 - First HS fair was a success with the help of teachers and parents who stepped to help at the last minute
 - There is strong administrative support for the students, especially because the IB program is challenging
 - Data indicates that TBLS students perform well academically, however, there are some attendance problems
 - TBLS has a 95% attendance rate
 - Absenteeism is primarily an issue for students who are at risk
 - There will be a proactive review of transcripts to identify where academic support is needed
 - Graduation rate is 98% but working on increase to 100%
 - Strong administration support for student voice
 - One TBLS student was on the podium at the recent Climate Change rally in downtown Manhattan and gave a speech
 - TBLS wishes to support all student extracurricular activity
 - Two teachers have stepped up to take over Ms. Billy's former role
 - Mr. Thomas, Dean of Culture
 - Addresses disciplinary issues, dress code, etc.
 - Ms. Kat Glass, Dean of Discipuli Support Services
 - Addresses academic issues
 - A council has been created to address Discipuli Life
 - Two Deans
 - Counselors, including Ms. Rebecca Davidson, who is the only person remaining from the old team
 - New counselors have been hired following a stringent, multi-step process
 - Families will be able to meet counselors on Family Night
 - Heads of Teaching and Learning
 - Ms. Capasso and Mr. Hill
 - o Mr. Wen Yee, for transfers and pupil path
 - Ms. Billy will have an Open Door Policy
 - o First Parent Coffee meeting to be held on 10/8 9:00-10:00 am
 - Strong interest in increasing outreach to parents

3. Student Voice: Student Miolin Richards reflects on the transition to TBLS

- Transition was hard the first year
 - First time in public school
 - Large building that's easy to get lost in
 - It was a big adjustment to be around 150 students
- Recommendation to incoming 9th grade students: don't doubt yourself

5. Questions for staff and students

- Q: As a Class I family how are the new college counselors? How will they get to know the students:
 - Ms. Davidson will be returning next month
 - Letters were written last year
 - Ms. Billy is the supervisor for the counselors
 - Counselors are having senior meetings
 - College counselors will be present on Family Night
- Q: Why did office hours end?
 - Office hours did not work as planned
 - Contract doesn't make it possible to execute office hours
 - Students who used it were not actually using the office hour but hanging out after school
 - Peer tutoring centers will opened in October
 - Students are being trained by teachers
- Q: when will clubs start?
 - Clubs will start in October
 - There will be no activities on Mondays and Tuesdays with the exception of sports
- Q: Why did conclave (study hall) end?
 - Not enough teacher coverage
 - It takes too much of the budget to have a teacher cover conclave
- Q: What is the impact of changes in new start time?
 - o It has improved lateness, less students arrive late
- Q: How can I volunteer to build Partnerships/Internships?
 - TBLS is interested in creating opportunities for partnerships for after school and summer internships with companies, like Google, etc.
- Q: How do we log in CAS hours?
 - This is a question for Mr. Thomas
 - Students use Manageback Portal and ask supervisor to approve reflection
- Q: How do you (Miolin) balance your time?
 - Doing too much outside of school to participate much in afterschool
 - Extracurricular activities include karate, violin, and piano
 - Her advisory voted her as tribune representative
 - She's on the Student Senate
 - She fundraises to help build the new student library
 - Miolin recalled her first impressions of TBLS and said she was not impressed until after attending Buddy Day because students looked like they were having fun
